



## Gala-Net Launches Open Beta Test of Aika Online

Tokyo, Japan – March 17, 2010 – Gala Inc. today announced that California-based Gala-Net Inc., a consolidated subsidiary of Gala Inc., has launched an open beta test of the U.S.-based English language version of Aika Online on its U.S. game portal site gPotato.com.

### 1. Overview of Aika Online

Aika Online is a MMORPG developed by Seoul-based developer JoyImpact Co., Ltd. that has won numerous accolades including Best Korean Game of the Year award of the 2009 Korean Game Awards. Players join one of five nations, and can war against each other in epic battles involving up to 2000 players. The game also features PRANs, fairy-like creatures that start as infants and can be brought up in various ways, and dressed up in apparel of the user's choice.
